## I-1 CURRICULUM DESIGN

The Superintendent shall be responsible for coordinating and maintaining the instructional program in accordance with the provisions of the state statues, rules, regulations and policies of the state Board of Education, and politics of the Board. The Superintendent shall visit the schools, observe the management and instruction and give suggestions for the improvement of the same. He/She shall advise with principals and teachers and shall endeavor in every way to promote public interest and improve educational conditions.

The Superintendent shall have prepared courses of study for the schools. Printed copies of the courses of study shall be supplied to every teacher and made available to the public if requested.

The organization and scheduling of subjects in the curriculum shall conform to the requirements of the State Department of Education. The curriculum shall be designed and implemented in a manner that affords all students the opportunity to achieve according to their abilities, interest, experiences and backgrounds.
