I-4 SUMMER SESSION

The summer session shall be provided as an extension of the schedule for the Opelika City Schools. The schedule for summer session shall provide for remedial instruction. The policies for the operation of schools in the summer session are as follows:

- Schools in the summer session shall be operated under general policies for the operation of schools in the regular term.
- Transportation shall be the responsibility of the student and the parent, unless otherwise announced.
- Schools in the summer session shall be scheduled to begin after the end of the regular school term as designed in the school calendar.
- Summer sessions may be offered for students in grades K-8 as well as a program for high school students needing remediation for the Alabama High School Graduation Exam.
- The summer session shall be staffed by certified teachers. The principal may vary assignments and number of hours for teachers to meet summer school teaching needs.
- The schedule for teachers shall include the required number of hours for instruction and other duties as assigned by the principals.
- Due to the concentrated method of instruction, no unexcused absences will be permitted during summer session for credit.
