CERTIFICATION INFORMATION:

Please read the following information carefully.

The issuance and validity of an Alabama School Bus Driver Certificate is dependent upon the following: (1) Approval of the applicant's application for certificate, (2) Successful completion of local school system training, (3) Successful completion of the SDE 12-hour class including a passing score on the written test, (4) Passing scores on all SDE-administered performance testing, (5) Issuance of a Class A or B commercial driver license with both passenger and school bus endorsements with no air-brake restriction, (6) Being suitable for public employment following a criminal history background check, and (7) Passing a pre-employment drug and alcohol test.

Once a driver has been issued an initial Alabama School Bus Driver Certificate, in order to maintain their certification, school bus drivers are required to participate in an annual 4-hour recertification class between January 1 and October 31 (Alabama Code § 16-27-1 (1975) and Rule 290-2-4.04). All bus driver certificates expire annually on December 31 Drivers who have attended a recertification class are issued an Alabama School Bus Driver Certificate for the next calendar year. They are not required to reapply. Drivers who fail to attend a recertification class must reapply and repeat the new driver training in order to be recertified. Pursuant to Alabama Code § 16-23-5 (1975) and the Alabama Administration Code r.290-3-2-.22 (2009), an Alabama School bus driver may have his/her Alabama School Bus Driver Certificate suspended and/or revoked when there is a danger to the public safety or welfare of schoolchildren or when the certificate holder has been guilty of immoral conduct or unbecoming or indecent behavior. This includes, but is not limited to, confirmed improper drug use, criminal convictions, failure to use the driver seat belt, unsafe driving, being uninsurable, or other just cause. If a holder of an Alabama Department of Education School Bus Driver Certificates fails to drive a school bus for a period of two years or more, the local supervisor may place the driver on Inactive Status. Once placed on the inactive list, the driver will be removed from the random drug testing list. An inactive certificate may be reactivated when the driver submits to a preemployment drug test, is placed on a random drug/alcohol schedule, and is retrained by the local school system before driving. An inactive status does not, however, nullify the certificate.

AUTHORIZATION:

I understand that my completion of this application is necessary in order to obtain an Alabama School Bus Driver Certificate and that my potential employment as a school bus driver rests solely with the above-named school system or other Alabama school system where I may apply. Under penalty of prosecution and dismissal, I hereby certify that the information presented on this application is true, accurate, and complete. I understand that misrepresentation or omission of pertinent facts may be cause for denial, revocation, or suspension of my Alabama School Bus Driver Certificate, denial of employment, or termination from employment. Further, I authorize the investigation of all statements contained herein and understand that any document relevant to this information may be reviewed by the agents of above-named school system or the Alabama Department of Education. I further declare that I am a citizen of the United States or an alien lawfully present in he United States. I understand that if at any time it is determined by the Alabama State Department of Education that I am not lawfully present in the United States, the Alabama State Department of Education will deny this benefit or will terminate this benefit. I understand that in accordance with Ala. Code 175 § 31-13-7 (h) "Any person who knowingly makes a false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or representation in a declaration executed pursuant to subsection (g) shall be guilty of perjury in the second degree pursuant to Section 13A-10-102."
