- Opelika City Schools is accepting online pre-registration applications for 2023-24 school year. Choose Opelika City Schools/Opelika High School. If you need assistance with accessing the online application, contact OCS Pre-K at 334-741-5623.
- Enrollment is open to all children four years of age on or before 9/2/2023* (children who are eligible for kindergarten are ineligible).
- Enrollees must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate (the certificate may be uploaded into the online pre-registration site or submitted directly to OCS Pre-K).
- Enrollees must provide two current proofs of residence (copies of power, water, or gas bill may be uploaded into the online pre-registration site or submitted directly to OCS Pre-K).
- Opelika City Schools Pre-K students must reside within Opelika city limits.
- No Registration Fee is required for this program.
- Upon enrollment, child's immunization record must be provided.
- No child will be denied participation on basis of income, sex, race, color, national origin, or disability.
